

“LE SYMBOLE DE PARIS”: TIMESCOPE LAUNCHES ITS NEW IMMERSIVE WALK ON THE CHAMP-DE-MARS

After a pilot phase in May, the virtual-reality experience dedicated to the Eiffel Tower opens to the public in June 2026.

The silhouette of the Eiffel Tower is known the world over – yet its true story still holds many secrets. Following the success of “**Les Origines de Paris**” – more than **30,000** visitors since June 2025, rated 4.9/5 – French start-up **Timescope** unveils its second chapter: “**Le Symbole de Paris**”, an unprecedented immersive walk on the Champ-de-Mars. Previewed in May, the experience instantly won over its very first visitors – rave reviews that herald a new hit for time travel, Parisian style.

Wearing a virtual-reality headset and accompanied by a guide, visitors explore the Champ-de-Mars for one hour, punctuated by **fifteen scenes recreated in 3D**: the battle of Lutetia, the Fête de la Fédération, the Tower's dizzying construction site, the 1889 World's Fair and the dark hours of the Occupation. A story in three acts, based on archives and validated by a committee of historians chaired by **Géraud Létang**, narrated by actress **Gaia Weiss** (French and English versions) and **Valquiria Huerta** (Spanish version).
